



Advisory Board Faculty Research and Creative

The Advisory Board Faculty Research Award (ABFRCA) is intended to support meritorious research and creative activity by full-time faculty of the college. Five awards in the amount of \$2000 each will be announced at the last meeting of the academic year for the Penn State Altoona Advisory Board.

All direct costs of research or creative activity are eligible for funding. Excluded are salaries, food, books or travel to professional meetings. Travel in support of research or creative activity is eligible for funding.

Faculty who have received other college support for their research or creative activity are eligible for this funding but the ABFRCAA must be used for some identifiable supplementary activity. All funding must spent by December 31st.

Applications are due April 15th and should be addressed to the Assistant Dean for Research.
